## **ALLEGHENY NATIONAL FOREST SEEKS APPLICATIONS FOR KINZUA BEACH FOOD CONCESSION PERMIT**

### *Public Notification*

Warren, Pa. – The Allegheny National Forest (NF) has issued a prospectus soliciting applications for a concession special use permit to provide food, sundries and recreational rental equipment for the Kinzua Beach Recreation Area on the Allegheny National Forest. A permit to provide food, sundries and rental equipment services at this government-owned recreation facility located on the Bradford Ranger District may be issued.

All proposals and applications must be submitted to Leanne Marten, Forest Supervisor, Attention: Jim Seyler, 4 Farm Colony Drive, Warren, Pennsylvania 16365. Proposals and applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) on May 7, 2010. Applicants must submit two copies of their application package and supporting documents.
